



Pursuant to Article 1.14 and 2.9, paragraph (1), point 2.a of the Election Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina („Official Gazette of BiH“, no. 23/01, 7/02, 9/02, 20/02, 25/02, 4/04, 20/04, 25/05, 52/05, 65/05, 77/05, 11/06, 24/06, 32/07, 33/08, 37/08, 32/10, 18/13, 7/14 and 31/16), the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina has on its 21st session held on May 4, 2016 passed the

DECISION ON ANNOUNCING AND ADMINISTERING 2016 LOCAL ELECTIONS

Article 1

Direct elections are announced for the following levels of government:

- 74 Municipal Councils in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (as in table 1),
- 57 Municipal Assemblies in the Republika Srpska (as in table 2),
- 131 mayors of municipalities in Bosnia and Herzegovina,
- 4 City Councils in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (as in table 3);
- 6 City Assemblies in Republika Srpska (as in table 4);
- 10 City mayors in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and
- Assembly of Brčko District of Bosnia and Herzegovina (as in table 5),

Article 2

Elections referred to in Article 1 of this decision will be held on October 2, 2016.

Article 3

(1) The elections for councilors to the City of Mostar Council cannot be announced having in mind that the Constitutional Court of Bosnia and Herzegovina has declared the provisions of Article 19.2, paragraphs (1) and (3) and Article 19.4, paragraphs (2) to (8) of the Election Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina unconstitutional by the Decision number 9/09 from November 26, 2010, confirming that the aforementioned provisions are null and void in its Decision number 9/09 from January 18, 2012.

(2) The elections for councilors to the City of Mostar Council shall be announced once appropriate legal conditions are in place.

Article 4

Integral parts of this decision are tables 1 to 5.

Article 5

This decision shall enter into the force on the day of its enactment and will be published in the “Official Gazette of BiH”, “Official Gazette of BiH Federation”, “Official Gazette of RS” and “Official Gazette of Brčko District BiH” and the web site of the BiH Central Election Commission www.izbori.ba.
