DECISION ON POSTPONMENT OF THE 2020 LOCAL ELECTIONS

Article 1 (Subject)

The 2020 Local Elections announced by the Decision of the BiH Central Election Commission number: 05-1-07-1-393-1/20 from May 7, 2020, scheduled for Sunday, October 4, 2020 are postponed since it is not possible to hold elections on that day in line with the provisions of the BiH Election Law.

Article 2 (Date of holding of postponed elections)

Postponed elections referred to in Article 1 of this Decision will be held on Sunday, November 15, 2020.

Article 3 (Entry into force and publication)

This decision shall enter into the force on the day of its enactment and will be published in the Official Gazette of BiH, Official Gazette of BiH Federation, Official Gazette of RS and Official Gazette of Brčko District BiH and on the website of the BiH Central Election Commission www.izbori.ba.
