



Pursuant to Article 1.14 and 2.9, paragraph (1), point 2.a of the Election Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina (Official Gazette of BiH, no. 23/01, 7/02, 9/02, 20/02, 25/02, 4/04, 20/04, 25/05, 52/05, 65/05, 77/05, 11/06, 24/06, 32/07, 33/08, 37/08, 32/10, 18/13, 7/14 and 31/16), the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina has on its 21st session held on May 7, 2020 passed the

DECISION ON CALLING AND ADMINISTERING 2020 LOCAL ELECTIONS

Article 1 (Authorities for which the elections are called)

(1) Direct elections are announced for:

- 64 Municipal Councils in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (as in table 1),
- 56 Municipal Assemblies in the Republika Srpska (as in table 2),
- 120 mayors of municipalities in Bosnia and Herzegovina,
- 14 City Councils in the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina (as in table 3);
- 7 City Assemblies in Republika Srpska (as in table 4);
- 22 City mayors in Bosnia and Herzegovina, and
- Assembly of Brčko District of Bosnia and Herzegovina (as in table 5).

(2) Tables 1 through 5 are integral part of this Decision.

Article 2 (Election date)

Elections referred to in Article 1 of this Decision shall be held on *Sunday, October 4, 2020*.

Article 3 (Elections in the City of Mostar)

(1) The elections for the councilors in the City of Mostar Council shall be announced once appropriate legal conditions for calling and administering the elections are met.

Article 4 (Instruction on deadlines and sequence of electoral activities)

The Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina shall adopt and publish the Instruction on deadlines and sequence of electoral activities for the 2020 Local Elections after the funds for the conduct of the 2020 Local Elections are secured in line with Article 1.2a, paragraph (6) of the Election Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina, respecting the decisions of the competent authorities in Bosnia and Herzegovina concerning the epidemic caused by COVID-19.

Article 5
(Entry into force and publication)

This decision shall enter into the force on the day of its enactment and will be published in the Official Gazette of BiH, Official Gazette of BiH Federation, Official Gazette of RS and Official Gazette of Brčko District BiH and on the website of the BiH Central Election Commission www.izbori.ba.
