



Pursuant to Articles 1.5 and 20.12a of the Election Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina (“Official Gazette of BiH” no. 23/01, 7/02, 9/02, 20/02, 25/02, 4/04, 20/04, 25/05, 52/05, 65/05, 77/05, 11/06, 24/06, 32/07 and 33/08), and Article 18 of the Rules of Procedure of the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina (“Official Gazette of BiH” number 50/07), upon the Proposition of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Bosnia and Herzegovina number: MFA-BA-MPK 08-1-7046/08, dated May 07, 2008, the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at its 20th session held on May 08, 2008, p a s s e d the following

DECISION

on diplomatic missions and consular posts of Bosnia and Herzegovina abroad, where it is planned to organize voting for the 2008 Local Elections

Article 1

For the 2008 Local Elections, for citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina temporarily living abroad who have the right to vote, it is planned to organize voting in the following diplomatic missions and consular posts of Bosnia and Herzegovina (hereinafter: BiH DMCP):

Article 2

According to the number of voters registered to vote in person in the BiH DMCP, the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina will, with a special regulation, establish the exact number and the assignment of polling stations in the BiH DMCP, regulate the complete voting procedure, as well as the manner of delivering the voting material from the BiH DMCP to the Main Counting Center in Sarajevo.

Article 3

(1) After the expiry of the deadline for the registration of voters registering to vote in the BiH DMCP, the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina will reach a final decision on the BiH DMCP in which voting will be organized.

(2) BiH Citizens who apply to vote in person in BiH DMCP referred to in Article 1 of this Decision in which the conditions for organizing voting are not fulfilled, will be enabled to vote by mail.

Article 4

This Decision shall enter into force upon the day of its adoption and it shall be published in the “Official Gazette of BiH”, the “Official Gazette of the FBiH”, the “Official Gazette of RS” and the “Official Gazette of the BiH District of Brčko”.
