



Pursuant to Article 2.9, paragraph (1), item 2., and with reference to Article 2.12, paragraphs (2) and (3) of the Election Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina (“Official Gazette of BiH” no. 23/01, 7/02, 9/02, 20/02, 25/02, 4/04, 20/04, 25/05, 52/05, 65/05, 77/05, 11/06, 24/06, 32/07 and 33/08), and Article 18 of the Rules of Procedure of the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at its 20th session held on May 08, 2008, p a s s e d the following

DECISION

on the criteria for determining the number of members of election commissions

Article 1 (Application)

This Decision shall establish the criteria for determining the number of members of municipal election commissions, the City Election Commissions of Mostar and Banja Luka, and the Election Commission of the BiH District of Brčko (hereinafter: election commission).

Article 2 (Number of Members of the Election Commission)

- (1) The number of members of the election commission shall be determined according to the number of voters registered in the excerpt from the Central Voters Register and according to the size of the municipality.
- (2) The election commission shall consist of three members for municipalities and cities in which up to 20 000 voters are registered in the excerpt from the Central Voters Register.
- (3) The election commission shall consist of five members for municipalities and cities in which up to 50 000 voters are registered in the excerpt from the Central Voters Register.
- (4) The election commission shall consist of seven members for municipalities and cities in which more than 50 000 voters are registered in the excerpt from the Central Voters Register.
- (5) The Election Commission of the BiH District of Brčko shall consist of seven members.

Article 3 (Other Criteria)

- (1) By way of derogation from the criteria given in Article 2, paragraph (2) of this Decision, the election commission may consist of five members due to indentedness of a municipality, or if more than 30 polling stations were designated.

(2) The Municipal Council/Municipal Assembly, the City Council/City Assembly shall submit to the BiH Central Election Commission a request for increasing the number of the members of the election commission referred to in paragraph (1) of this Article for approval, together with an explanation.

Article 4
(Entry into Force)

(1) The Decision on determining the number of members of election commissions (“Official Gazette BiH”, number 40/06) shall become ineffective upon the entry into force of this Decision.

(2) This Decision shall enter into force upon the day of its adoption, and it shall be published in the “Official Gazette of BiH”, the “Official Gazette of FBiH”, the “Official Gazette of RS” and the “Official Gazette of BiH District of Brčko”.
