



Pursuant to Articles 1.5 and 20.12a of the Election Law of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH", Nos. 23/01, 7/02, 9/02, 20/02, 25/02, 4/04, 20/04, 25/05, 52/05, 65/05, 77/05, 11/06, 24/06, 32/07, 33/08, 32/10, 18/13, 7/14, 31/16, 41/20, 38/22, 51/22, 67/22 and 24/24) and Article 18 of the Rules of Procedure of the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina ("Official Gazette of BiH", Nos. 29/18, 25/20 and 32/23), the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina, at its 29th session held on 6 May 2026, adopted the following

D E C I S I O N

on the Diplomatic-Consular Missions of Bosnia and Herzegovina where voting is planned to be organized for the 2026 General Elections

Article 1.

(Diplomatic-Consular Missions of Bosnia and Herzegovina abroad where voting is planned to be organized)

At the 2026 General Elections in Bosnia and Herzegovina, voting is planned to be organized for citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina who have the right to vote and are residing abroad at the following diplomatic-consular missions of Bosnia and Herzegovina (hereinafter: DCMs of BiH):

Article 2.
(Number and distribution of polling stations in the DCMs of BiH)

The Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina shall determine, by a separate regulation, the exact number and distribution of polling stations in the DCMs of BiH according to the number of voters registered to vote in person at the DCMs of BiH.

Article 3.
(Final decision on the DCMs of BiH where voting will be organized)

(1) After the expiry of the registration deadline for voters registering to vote at the DCMs of BiH, the Central Election Commission of Bosnia and Herzegovina shall adopt the final decision on the DCMs of BiH where voting will be organized.

(2) Citizens of Bosnia and Herzegovina who apply to vote in person at the DCMs of BiH referred to in Article 1 of this Decision, but where the conditions for organizing voting are not met, shall be allowed to vote by mail.

Article 4.
(Entry into force and publication)

This Decision shall enter into force on the day of its adoption and shall be published in the Official Gazette of BiH, Official Gazette of the Federation of BiH, Official Gazette of Republika Srpska, Official Gazette of the Brčko District of BiH and on the website of the Central Election Commission of BiH at www.izbori.ba.
